Dear Parents and Guardians,

Thank you for completing the testing form and consent. We are delighted to have had such a positive response and look forward to welcoming back nearly 400 pupils to test on Saturday.

Year groups will be tested at the times indicated below. **Older siblings are asked to attend with their younger sibling where possible.**

Procedures for Saturday are as follows:

- On arrival at School, please park in a parking bay and **stay in your vehicle**.
- Once safely parked, your child should leave the vehicle and head towards the testing site in the Sports Hall using the crossings and footpaths. House staff will be on the drive to greet and supervise children. Parents are requested to remain in their vehicle throughout.
- Pupils should wear a face covering at all times and should socially distance from other pupils and staff when walking to and from the Sports Hall.
- On arrival at the Sports Hall, pupils will register and will be allocated a testing bay. Testing staff at each bay will provide reassurance, guidance and support. Pupils should not be concerned.
- Pupils will be reminded to use hand sanitiser frequently when in the testing site.
- Once the test is complete, pupils should leave the Sports Hall and return to your vehicle. **They do not need to wait for their test result.**

- You are then free to depart.

The testing staff will only contact you following the test, if the result is positive. If you are not contacted, your child has successfully completed their first negative test and can return to School on Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March as planned.
