Learning@home

No fee discount on day fees will be given during periods of remote learning. Refunds for lunches may be considered in the event of further lockdowns.

Barney offers a range of extended care and boarding options, ranging from Flexi Boarding, Occasional Boarding and extended day options.

Flexi Boarding has the benefit for pupils of having a set bedroom allocated for their use, and there is a **minimum commitment of four nights a week**. If a less formal arrangement is required and your child just needs to board for the occasional night on an ad hoc basis then Occasional Boarding would be more suitable.

Extras

Barney does its best to keep chargeable extras to a minimum, but extras include (though are not limited to), any bus fares, individual music tuition, learning support lessons or LAMDA lessons. Bus fares are charged in advance but most other extras are charged in arrears each term. Lunches are included in the fees, as are text books (unless not returned at the end of the year).

Music lessons are charged at £18.50 per lesson. Please contact our Director of Music, Mr Richard Dawson for more details (rjd@barneyschool.org.uk). There is a stock of musical instruments for hire with charges from £20 a term for small instruments, £30 for larger instruments and £40 for a drum kit.

Learning support lessons are charged at £20 per lesson. Please contact Mrs Judith Gibbons (jag@barneyschool.org.uk) for more details.

LAMDA lessons are charged at £16 per lesson with a reduced cost for shared lessons. Please contact Mrs Emily Wilson (erw@barneyschool.org.uk) for further details.

School bus services are available, covering a wide area. Further details are available under the Bus Services section on the School's website. Please contact transport@barneyschool.org.uk to make arrangements.

The Old Barnardian Club has a one-off lifetime subscription charge of £120, payable in 3 instalments over your child's first year in Senior School.

External examinations such as GCSEs and A Levels attract entry fees from the relevant examination boards and these fees will be passed onto parents in advance of the examinations. Average charges in 2021 for GCSEs were around £400-£500 and £300-500 for A-levels.

Registration

A registration fee of £75 (£150 for non-UK residents) is payable when returning the registration form to the Registrar. This fee is non-refundable and parents should note that registration does not necessarily guarantee a place will be offered.

Deposit

If your child is offered a place at Barney and you accept it, there is a deposit to pay, returned without interest when your child leaves.

Sibling discounts apply provided all siblings are attending Barney at the same time

Armed forces discounts cannot be combined with other fee remissions.

Our Parent Contract, binding from acceptance of an offer of a place at Barney, contains detailed provisions regarding payments, fees and charges and parents should note that these will be strictly adhered to.

Notice required

A full term's notice is required to give notice of intention of your child leaving Barney, otherwise a term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged. Equally, if your child intends to change their boarding status in any way, including a change in the number of Flexi Boarding nights, then a full term's notice should be given to avoid being charged fees in lieu.

If your child will no longer require school bus transport then half a term's notice should be given. Music, LAMDA and Learning Support lessons also require half a term's notice to be given if your child is to cease taking lessons.
