Extras in advance

- Termly bus fares
School bus services are available, covering a wide area. Details are available under the [Transport section](#) on the School's website. Please contact transport@barneyschool.org.uk to make arrangements.
- School device leasing
All students in Years 7–11 will be provided with a mandatory, school-managed device at a termly charge of £50 (Years 7 and 8) and £75 (Years 9–11), inclusive of VAT. Students in the Sixth Form may bring their own device that meets the minimum requirements for their chosen subjects or opt in to a school-managed device. These are chargeable at £150 per term, inclusive of VAT.
- GCSE and A-level external examination board fees
External examinations such as GCSEs and A Levels attract entry fees from the relevant examination boards and these fees will be passed onto parents in advance of the examinations. Average charges in 2026 for GCSEs were around £600-£700 and £450-£550 for A-levels. An estimate based on this will be spread across the three termly invoices with any balance applied on the Trinity fee invoice.

The Old Barnardians' Club has a one-off lifetime subscription charge of £144 (inc VAT), payable in 3 instalments over your child's first year in Senior School.

Registration

A registration fee (inclusive of VAT) of £114 (£228 for non-UK residents) is payable when returning the registration form to the Registrar. This fee is non-refundable, and parents should note that registration does not necessarily guarantee a place will be offered.

Deposit

If your child is offered a place at Barney and you accept it, there is a deposit to pay which is returned without interest when your child leaves.

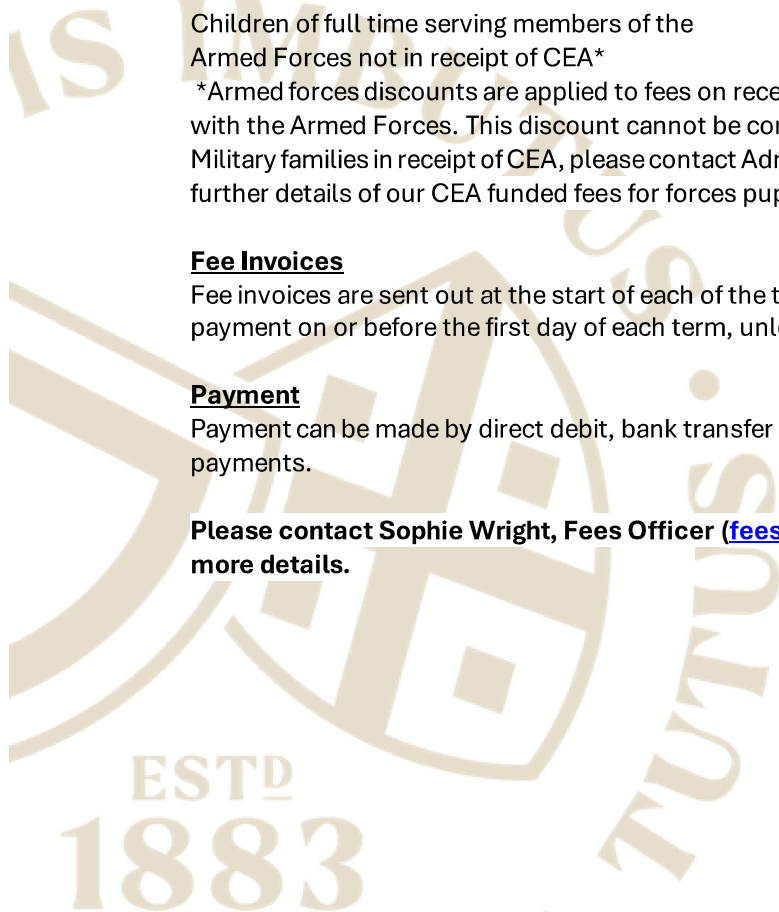
Fee Invoices

Fee invoices are sent out at the start of each of the three main school holidays and are due for payment on or before the first day of each term, unless paying by direct debit.

Payment

Payment can be made by direct debit, bank transfer or card payment, or via Flywire for international payments.

Notice required.

A **full term's notice** is required to give notice of intention of your child **leaving** Barney, otherwise a term's fees in lieu of notice will be charged. Please note that this also applies at the **end of Year 6 and end of Year 11** should your child not wish to continue their journey into Senior School or Sixth Form.

Equally, if your child intends to **change their boarding status** in any way, including a change in the number of Flexi Boarding nights, then a **full term's notice** should be given to avoid being charged fees in lieu.

Half a term's notice should be given if your child will no longer require **school bus transport. Music, LAMDA and Academic Support lessons** also require **half a term's notice** to be given if your child is to cease taking lessons.

Our Parent Contract, binding from acceptance of an offer of a place at Barney, contains detailed provisions regarding payments, fees and charges and parents should note that these will be strictly adhered to.
