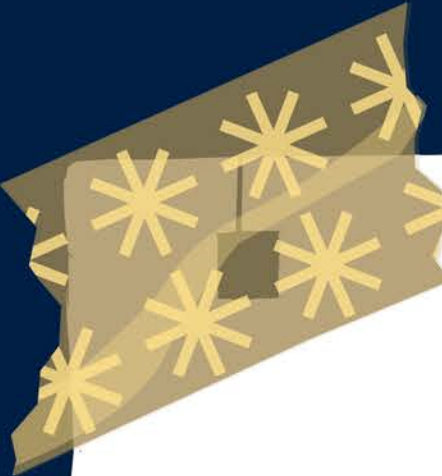

Playground with your friends



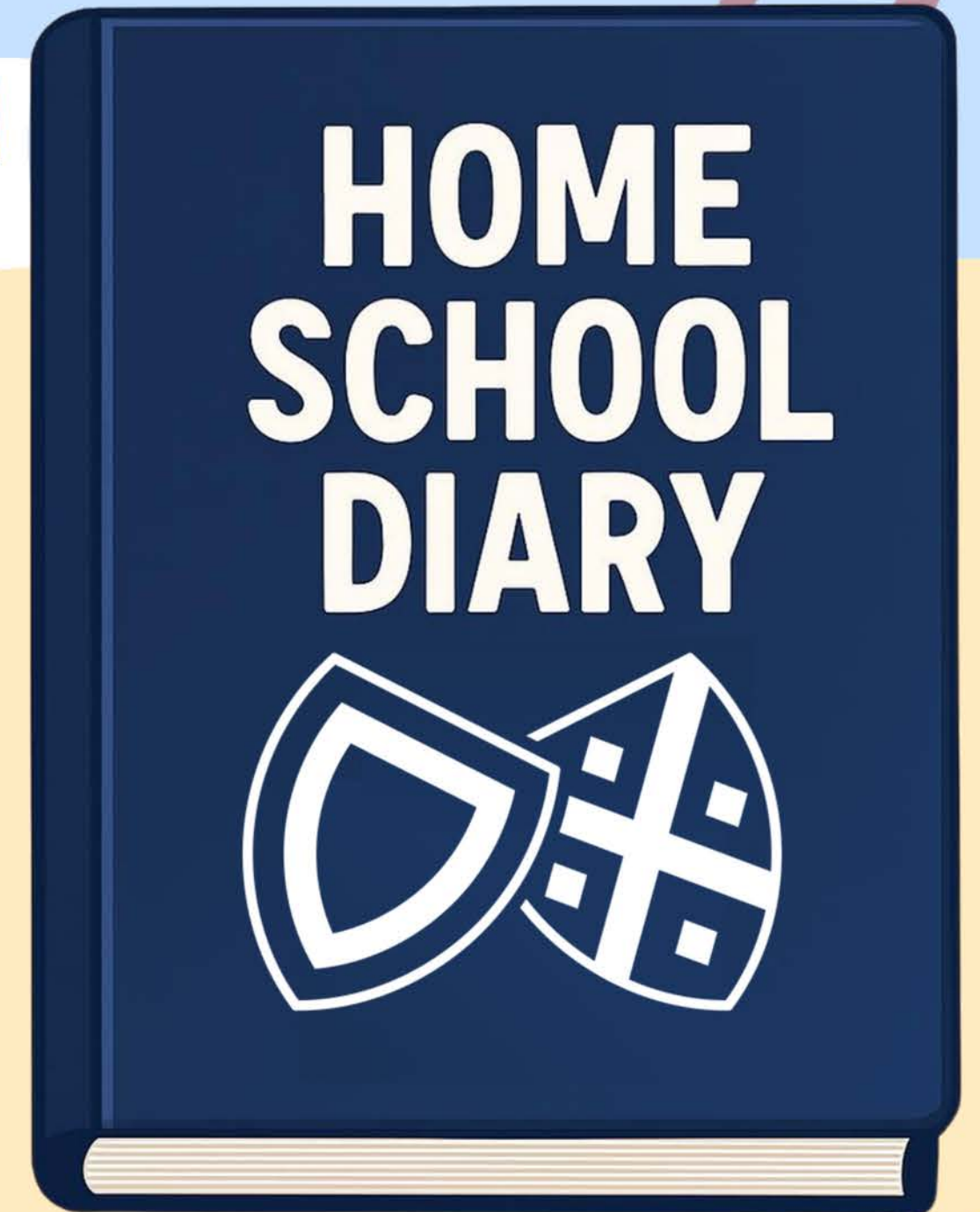
HOME SCHOOL DIARY

How you interact with people

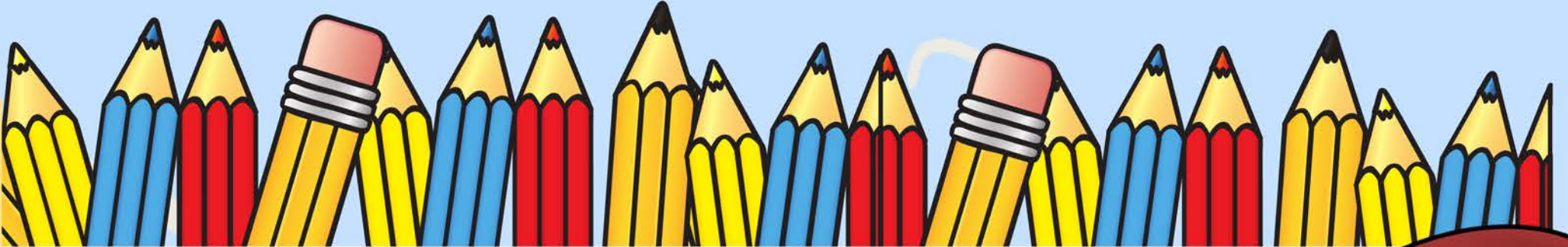

Our Prep School Superheroes help us learn about **kindness**, **confidence**, **resilience** and **teamwork** every single day





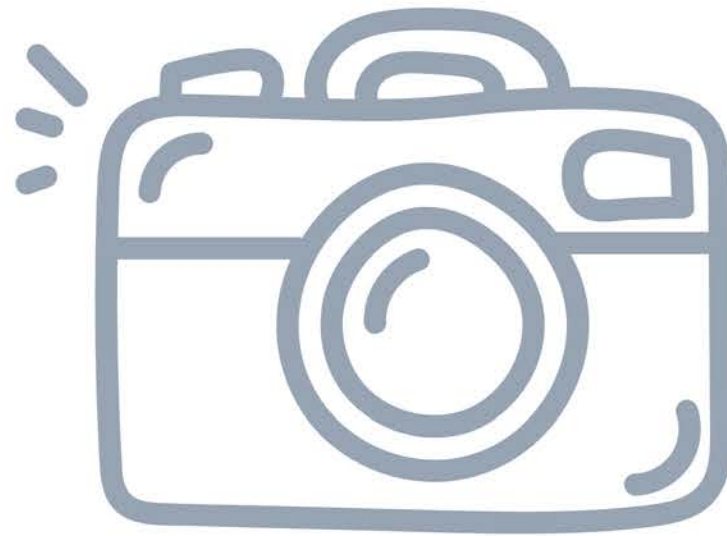
