Each day you should write down:

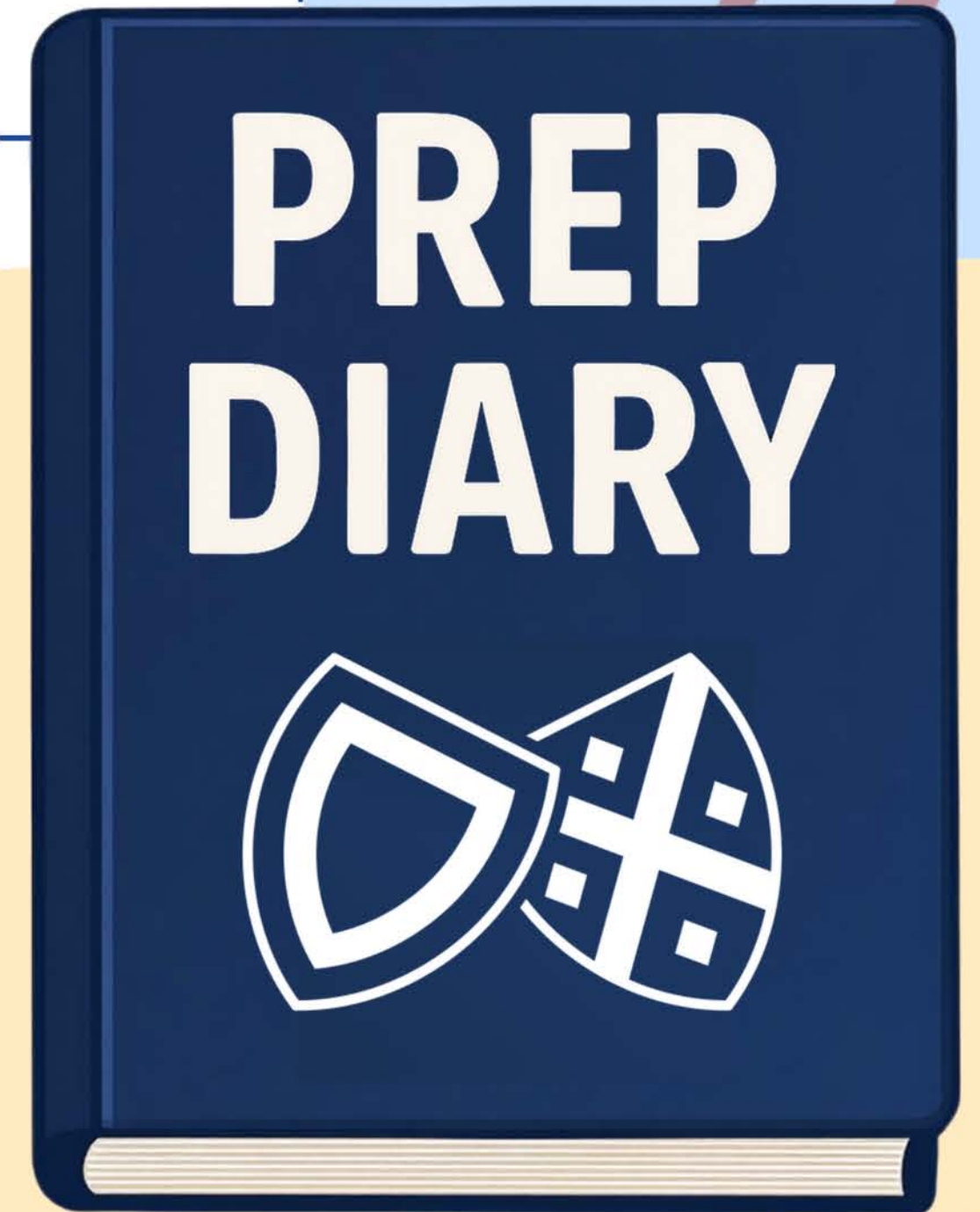
All homework tasks

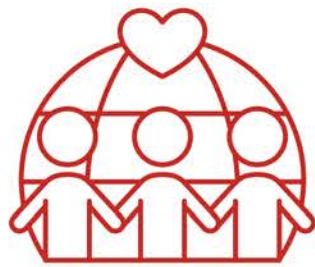

If you are selected to play in a team, your name will appear on a team sheet

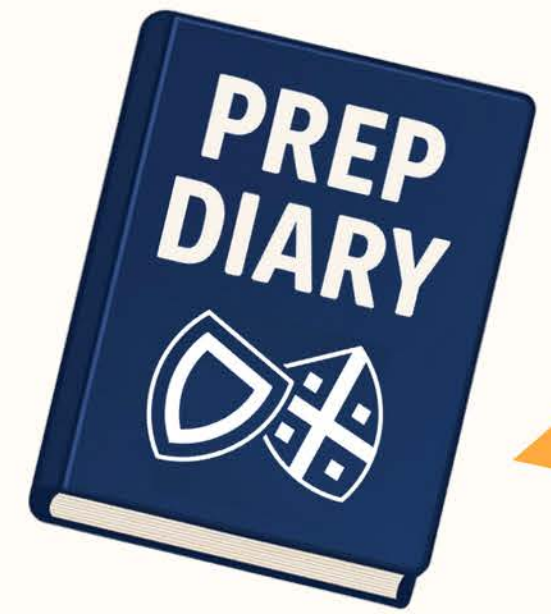

ALL WEATHERS

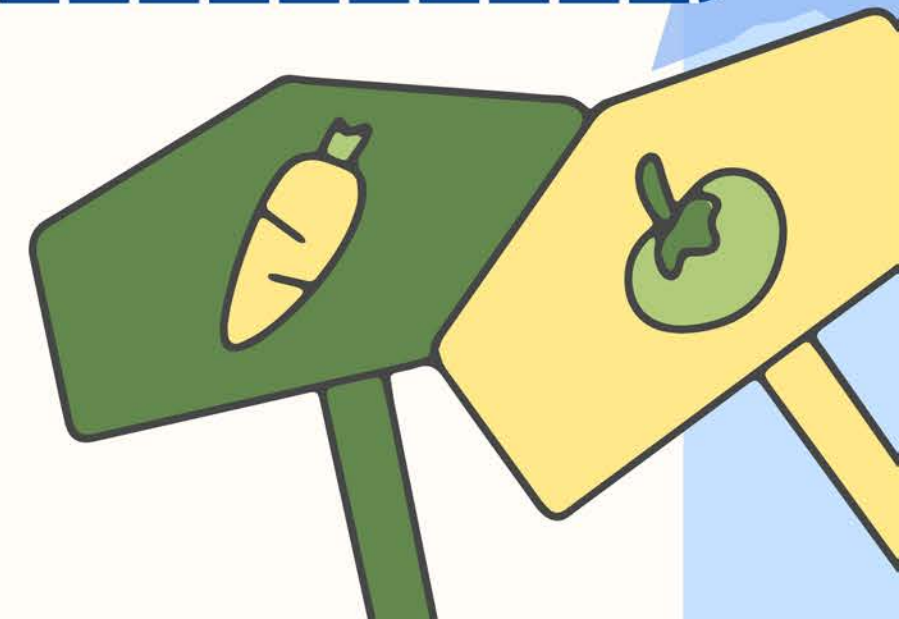
OUTDOOR EDUCATION

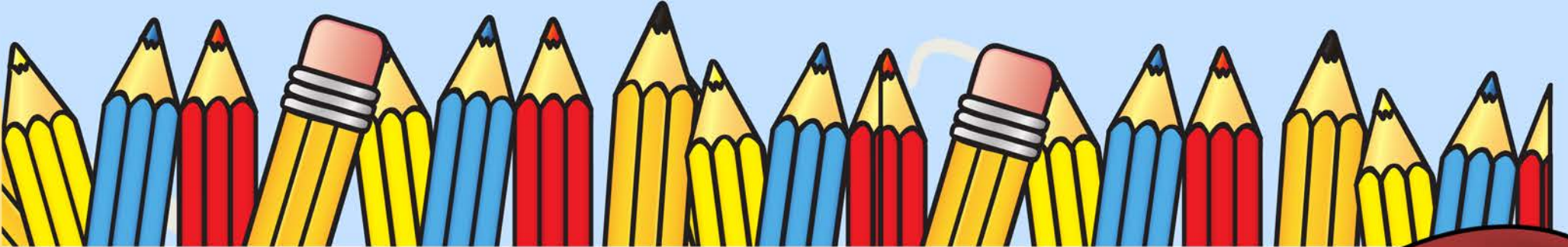

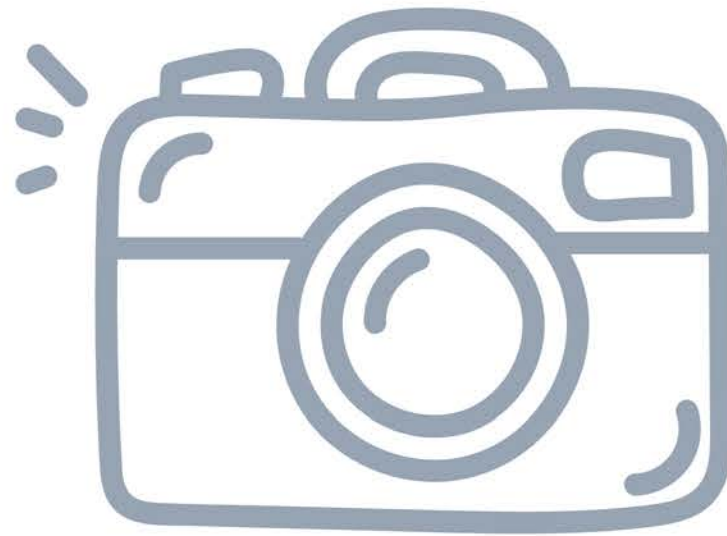
